**A 2 day Painting Workshop for Oil or Acrylic Painters**

October 26 and 27, 2019 10--4 at the beautiful Comox Marina Sails



"In this two day course we will explore how to create the illusion of light on the canvas. It is simply a matter of learning firstly to see accurately, and then developing a process for arriving at a mixture that will be correct. We will be working at both training the eye and then translating that information into paint.

We will start with an interactive demo on subtractive color mixing that will make the process of arriving at the right mixture (value, saturation and hue) straightforward, then students will put the lesson straight into practice, first with exercises and then onto a series of small paintings that will serve to reinforce the principles learned. I will provide photo references for the workshop. My goal is to simply and demystify the act of creating light on the canvas, through seeing and then using the correct color and value mixtures. "

...from Gaye Adams: I have been drawing and painting as long as I can remember; a sketchbook was always close by. I did not ever plan to become a painter – no one ever presented it to me as something to do as anything more than a pleasant pastime, and it has become my greatest passion. I find my path as an artist continues to involve but I am ever inspired by the pursuit of painting light. Light bounces, dances, illuminates – it is the impetus...
